Program Overview

Children's Cardiovascular Program is one of the largest programs in the region with 480 cardiac surgeries, 500 cath procedures provided by 3 cardiac surgeons and 4 invasive cardiologists along with 14,185 echos (1,477 fetal) performed in 2019. Our Cardiovascular Care Center on the Minneapolis Campus is comprised of 33 beds, 2 operating rooms (one with hybrid capabilities), biplane cath lab, preoperative area, state of the art simulation lab, and spacious conference center. Our Program delivers a full range of services from imaging tests to pioneering surgeries and provides care for neonates, children, teens, and adults born with heart defects.
