Cardiac intensivists from Children’s Hospital of Pittsburgh assist in patient care through telemedicine consultation and work in conjunction with the local faculty. The pediatric cardiac surgical program performs over 250 cases/year (150 cases utilizing cardiopulmonary bypass) and works in partnership with Children’s Hospital of Pittsburgh, under the leadership of Dr. Victor Morell who is internationally recognized for his expertise.
