Since its formation in 2003, PCICS has grown to almost 1,000 members in over 30 countries. Our members are healthcare professionals dedicated to promoting scientific inquiry, acquiring knowledge, and improving practice for our critically ill pediatric patients with congenital and acquired heart disease.

Purpose of PCICS

- Support, encourage and promote excellence in clinical care and research in the field of pediatric cardiac critical care
- Encourage collegial relationships among pediatric sub-specialists and the interprofessional team
- Improve the level of care of neonatal, pediatric and adult patients with congenital heart disease; pediatric patients with acquired cardiovascular disease; and pediatric patients after cardiac surgery
- Promote basic, translational, and clinical research related to pediatric patients in heart disease
- Organize international scientific meetings
- Facilitate links between complementary international and national professional colleges and societies
- Promote and disseminate related quality/safety and educational materials through established and developing communication technologies

We anticipate 700+ participants at the PCICS 18th Annual Meeting.

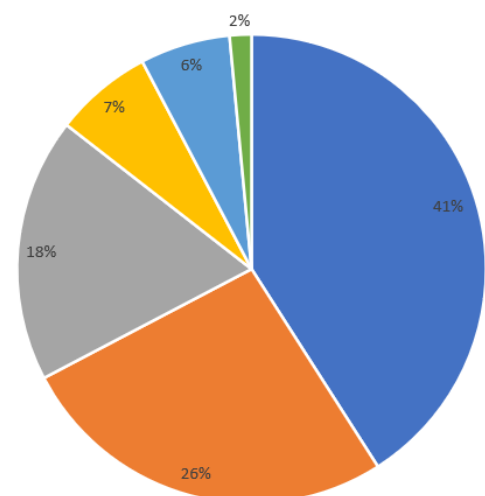

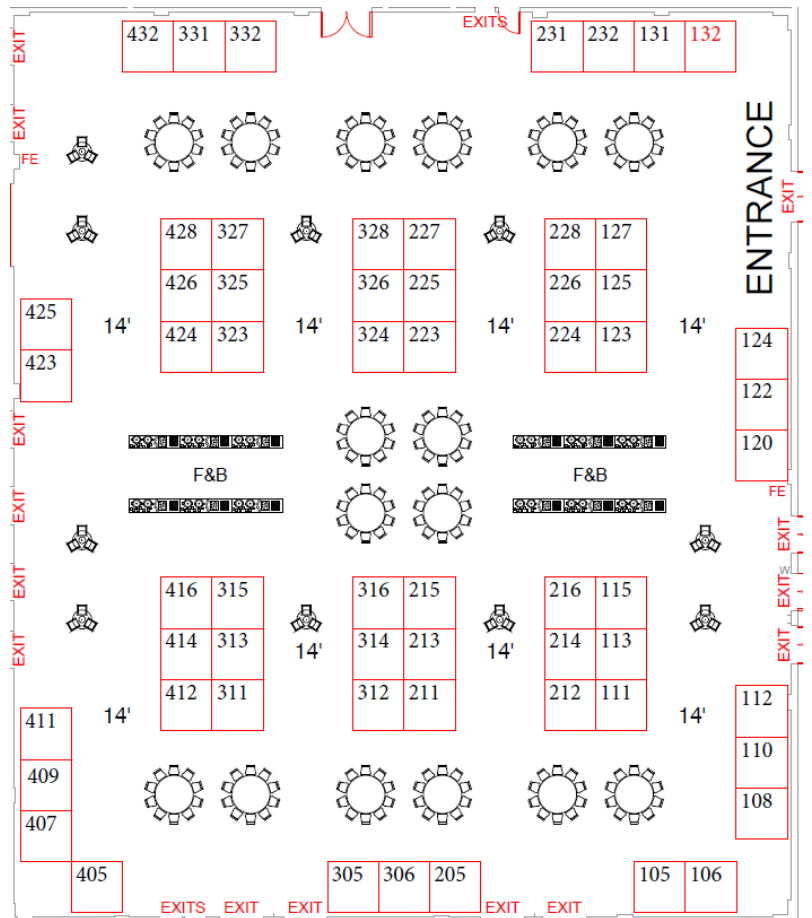
